

# City of Winfield Collection Guidelines

## Prepare for Pickup

**Collection Day:** Garbage collection is **MONDAY**. Recycling collection is **THURSDAY**. All carts should be **curbside by 6:00 AM**.

**Materials:** All waste materials must be **INSIDE** the provided cart (Garbage in the garbage cart, Recycling in the recycling cart). Items placed outside the cart will NOT be collected. [Extra carts may be requested for an additional monthly fee.]

**Weight Limits:** Carts **CANNOT** exceed sixty (60) lb. each.

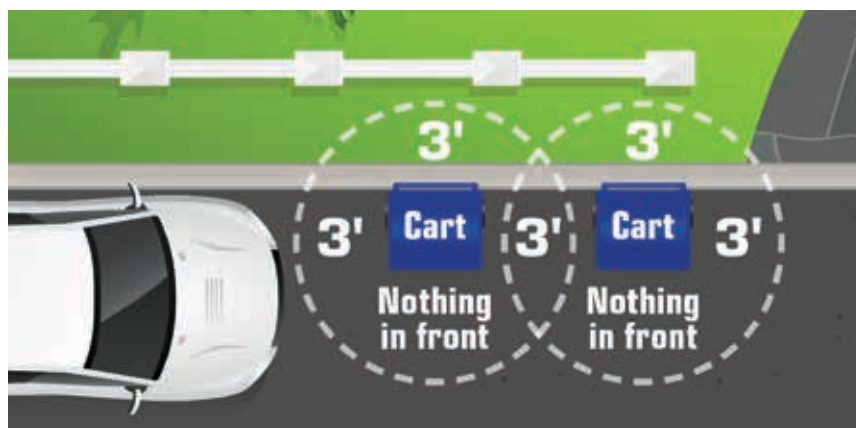
## Holiday Schedule

If the holiday falls on or prior to your regular collection day, pick-up will be delayed by one day through the end of that week.

**Holidays Observed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

## Cart Placement

Carts MUST be **LESS THAN three (3) ft.** from the curb and MUST be **AT LEAST three (3) ft. away** from any standing object (this includes mailboxes, vehicles, and other waste containers).



**Hazardous waste will NOT be collected.**

## Garbage

- Collected **weekly**
- 95 gallon cart
- Materials Accepted: Containerized, non-hazardous municipal solid waste

## Recycling Curbside

- Collected **weekly**
- 65 gallon cart
- Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.

## Recycling Drop-Off

- Materials Accepted: Mixed paper

## Bulk Waste

- Must call to schedule in advance.
- One item collected per month at no charge; collected last week of the month. \$20 fee per additional item or for pickups scheduled on a different day.
- Materials Accepted: Sofas, toilets, sinks, mattresses, carpet, fencing, etc.
- Weight Limit: 75 lb. and able to be picked up by one person

## White Goods

- Call to schedule. Cost per item.
- Materials Accepted: Stoves, washers, dryers, etc.

## Roll-Off Services

- Individual residents may contract with Meridian Waste to collect additional bulk, construction, and demolition waste from property clean-up.

**ATTENTION:** All materials must be **INSIDE** the appropriate cart provided by Meridian Waste. Any items placed outside the cart will **NOT** be collected.

## GARBAGE CART

### APPROVED Waste

- YES** — Non-hazardous municipal solid waste
- YES** — Food scraps and food packaging
- YES** — Disposables
- YES** — Clothing
- YES** — Compost
- YES** — Bottles, cans, newspapers & magazines
- YES** — Glass

### NOT ACCEPTABLE

- NO** — Tires
- NO** — Yard waste
- NO** — **Hazardous Materials:** Including but not limited to: batteries; automotive fluids (fuel, antifreeze, oils); paint and paint lacquer, stains, thinners, varnish and polishes; wood preservatives; and chemicals of any kind (i.e. pool chemicals, cleaners, solvents, adhesives; pesticides and weed killer)
- NO** — **Empty Hazardous Material Containers**
- NO** — **Radioactive Materials**
- NO** — **Biological/Medical Waste**
- NO** — **Electronic Waste:** Including but not limited to: televisions, computers, monitors, printers, VCRs, cell phones, telephones, radios and microwave ovens
- NO** — Liquids or Water-Soluble Solids
- NO** — Salt, borax, lye, caustics/acids
- NO** — Septic Tank or Chemical Toilet Waste
- NO** — Fluorescent Light Tubes and Ballasts
- NO** — Automobile Bodies

## RECYCLING CART

The following are accepted for curbside recycling: plastics (#s 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7); aluminum, tin, and steel cans; newspaper, magazines, junk mail, office paper, tissue or cereal boxes, and other clean cardboards.

**NOTE:** Items must be clean, with non-paper items rinsed and labels removed.

\* NOT Accepted: #4, #6 & black plastics

### NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE: GLASS

Glass is not accepted in the curbside recycling program due to it being a common contaminant in the recycling stream.

## RECYCLING DROP-OFF

Mixed paper recycling can be dropped off at **Winfield Transfer Station & Recycling**. Paper **MUST** be separated from other items and placed in one of the designated containers.
